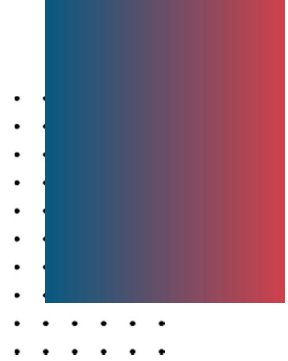

Required information on declaration of goods for personal use
transporting across the border of the Republic of Armenia

The purpose of this guide is to provide information on declaration of goods transporting across the border of the Republic of Armenia.



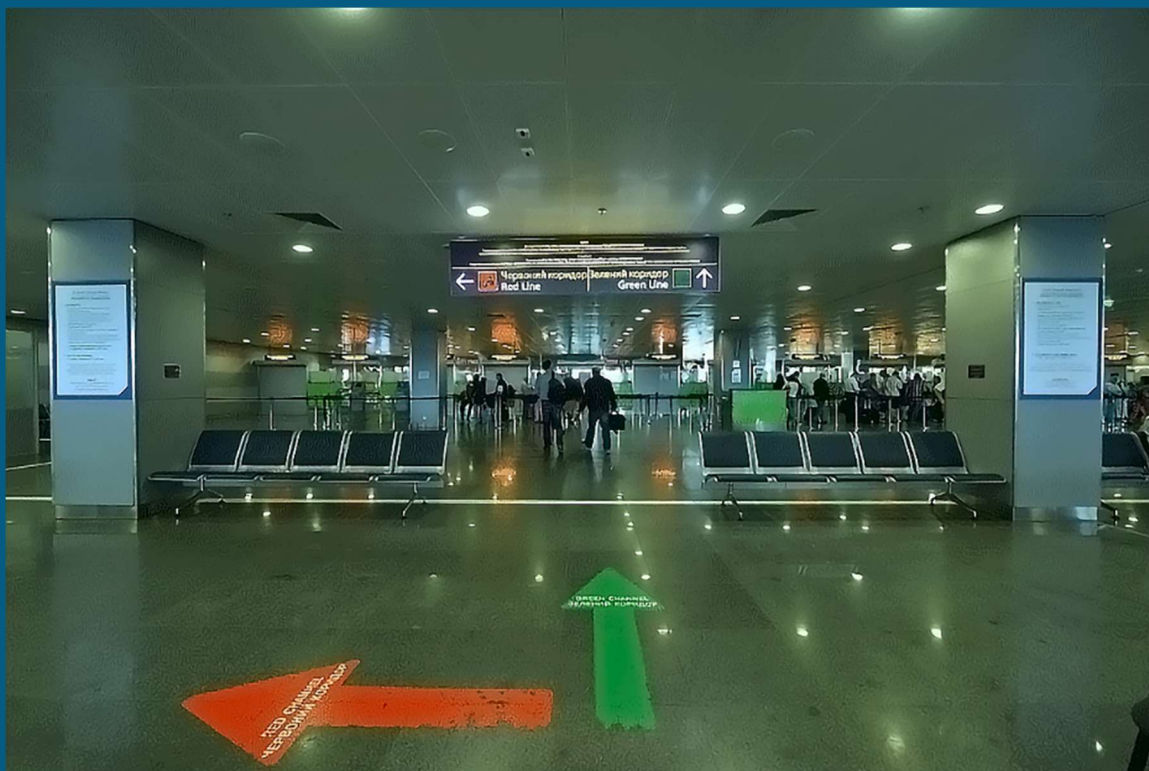
TO BE AWARE OF UPON ARRIVING IN THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Attention

1. What should I do if the goods I transport across the border of the Republic of Armenia in accompanied and/or unaccompanied baggage are subject to declaration, or if I do not know whether I can transport goods in accompanied or unaccompanied baggage without declaring?

If you have goods subject to declaration or you are not sure that they are not subject to declaration, then choose **the Red channel** and fill out a passenger customs declaration.

Attention

Goods purchased in duty-free shops located in places where goods are transported across the border of the Republic of Armenia by individuals who arrived in the Republic of Armenia are considered as goods for personal use imported into the territory of the Republic of Armenia in accompanied baggage by an individual.

2. How should the declaration of goods for personal use be carried out?

The declaration of goods for personal use is carried out by filling out a passenger customs declaration and submitting it to the customs authority.



3. In what language can I fill out a passenger customs declaration in the Republic of Armenia?

You can fill out a passenger customs declaration in Armenian, Russian, or English, and with the permission of the customs authority, in another foreign language, which is mastered by the officials of the customs authority, where this customs declaration shall be submitted.

At your desire, you can print, fill out, and sign the blank and submit the already filled-out passenger declaration to the customs authority when crossing the border.

4. Which goods are subject to mandatory declaration?

Goods subject to mandatory declaration are:

- 1) Goods for personal use transported across the border of the Republic of Armenia in unaccompanied luggage, or goods for personal use delivered by a carrier;
- 2) goods for personal use transported across the border of the Republic of Armenia in any manner in respect of which compliance with prohibitions and restrictions is carried out in accordance with the Customs Code of the Eurasian Economic Union (hereinafter referred to as “the Code”) and submission of documents and/or information for compliance with these prohibitions and restrictions is required;
- 3) goods for personal use in respect of which customs duties and taxes are subject to payment;
- 4) goods for personal use imported in accompanied luggage with the exemption from payment of customs duties and taxes;
- 5) Vehicles for personal use transported across the border of the Republic of Armenia in any manner, except vehicles for personal use registered in the member states;



6) temporary imported vehicles for personal use located in the territory of the Republic of Armenia, in cases of their re-exportation, release for the purpose of free circulation, transfer to other persons in accordance with the legislation.

7) cash funds and/or traveler's checks, if the total amount of such cash funds and/or traveler's checks, at their one-time importation into the customs territory of the Republic of Armenia or one-time exportation from the customs territory of the Republic of Armenia exceeds the equivalent of 10,000 US dollars at the current exchange rate as of the date of submission of the passenger customs declaration to the customs authority;

8) monetary instruments, except traveler's checks;

9) cultural values in respect of which prohibitions and restrictions are applied in accordance with the legislation.

10) goods for personal use sent via international postal items;

11) for replaced parts (spare parts) of temporarily exported vehicles in the case established in paragraph 3 of Article 265 of the Code;

12) when transporting coffins with bodies (remains) and urns with ashes of deceased persons across the border of the Republic of Armenia, a free form application can be used as a passenger customs declaration issued by a person accompanying the coffin with the body (remains) or an urn with ashes of deceased persons.



5. When transporting through the territory of the Republic of Armenia by air transport, after arriving in the territory of the Republic of Armenia, if I leave the territory of the Republic of Armenia without exiting the transit zone of the international airport, are goods for personal use transported in accompanied baggage subject to declaration?

When transporting through the territory of the Republic of Armenia by air transport, after arriving in the territory of the Republic of Armenia, if you leave the territory of the Republic of Armenia without exiting the transit zone of the international airport, then your goods for personal use transported in accompanied baggage are not subject to declaration.



6. Upon arriving in the Republic of Armenia, do I have to declare goods for personal use in all cases transported in accompanied baggage and not exceeding the permissible quantities without payment of customs duties and taxes provided for by the legislation?

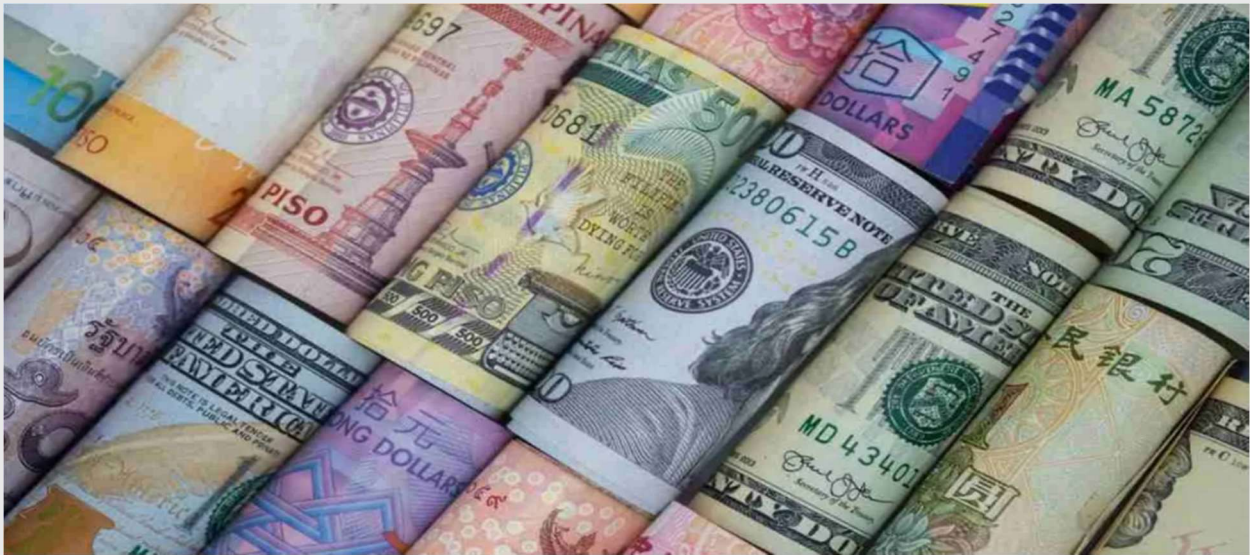
If goods for personal use transported in your accompanied baggage across the border of the Republic of Armenia do not exceed the permissible quantities without payment of customs duties and taxes and, are not required to comply with prohibitions and restrictions on these products in accordance with Article 7 of the Code, and/or you are not transporting goods subject to mandatory declaration in accordance with the legislation, then you can choose the Green channel of the customs control and cross the border of the Republic of Armenia without written declaration of goods.

Attention

A crossing of the finish line of customs operations by an individual without filling out a passenger customs declaration shall be deemed a statement of the individual confirming the absence of goods subject to customs declaration.

7. When are cash funds and/or traveler's checks at their one-time importation into the territory of the Republic of Armenia or one-time exportation from the territory of the Republic of Armenia subject to declaration?

If the total amount of cash funds and/or traveler's checks, at their one-time importation into the territory of the Republic of Armenia or one-time exportation from the territory of the Republic of Armenia, exceeds the equivalent of 10,000 US dollars at the current exchange rate as of the date of submission of the passenger customs declaration to the customs authority.



Attention

When crossing the customs territory of the EAEU, an individual who has cash and monetary instruments exceeding the equivalent of 100,000 US dollars at the current exchange rate must declare not only the amount but also submit documents that confirm the origin of these funds. In particular, it is about a bank document on withdrawing monetary funds from an account, as well as exchange (conversion) actions, a loan receipt document, as well as the documents that confirm the execution of civil and legal transactions (for example, receiving inheritance and donations).

8. Can I declare goods that are not subject to customs declaration at my desire?

Yes, an individual, at his or her desire, has the right to declare goods for personal use that are not subject to mandatory declaration.

Attention

If an individual makes a temporary export of goods, he or she can fill out a passenger customs declaration for these goods and apply to the customs authority to carry out identification of the temporarily exported goods for personal use if such identification may contribute to their re-import into the territory of the Republic of Armenia without payment of customs duties and taxes. The identification of goods for personal use shall be indicated in the customs declaration, one copy of which shall be given to the individual carrying out the temporary export of such goods from the territory of the Republic of Armenia.



9. If I import goods for personal use in unaccompanied baggage, are these goods subject to declaration?

The goods transported in unaccompanied baggage are subject to mandatory declaration.

10. What should you do if, upon arriving in the territory of the Republic of Armenia, you have both accompanied baggage and unaccompanied or only unaccompanied baggage?

If you arrive in the Republic of Armenia and you have unaccompanied luggage (for example, your accompanied luggage, which for reasons beyond your control, did not arrive) crossing the border of the Republic of Armenia choose **the Red channel** and fill out a passenger customs declaration, otherwise the customs authorities *will have to consider the goods in your unaccompanied baggage as exceeding the permissible quantities for transporting across the border of the Republic of Armenia without payment of customs duties and taxes* (even if the goods you are transporting across the border of the Republic of Armenia including unaccompanied baggage do not exceed the permissible quantities for transporting across the border of the Republic of Armenia without payment of customs duties and taxes) and if you do not prove the contrary, you will have to pay customs duties and taxes in accordance with the legislation.

Attention

Accompanied baggage are goods for personal use, including hand luggage, which are transported across the border of the Republic of Armenia during the actual entry of an individual into the territory of the Republic of Armenia or its departure from the territory of the Republic of Armenia.

Unaccompanied baggage are goods for personal use that are owned by an individual and transferred or being transferred to the carrier under an international transportation contract (freight transport), confirmed by transport (shipping) documents, for the actual transportation across the border of the Republic of Armenia in connection with the entry or departure of such person to or from the territory of the Republic of Armenia (for example, delayed baggage).



11. Who can act as declarants of goods for personal use?

As declarants of goods for personal use, there can be individuals at least 16 years old from the member states or foreign individuals.

1) who, at the time of crossing the border of the Republic of Armenia, have the right of possession, use, and/or disposal in respect of goods for personal use transported across the border of the Republic of Armenia in accompanied baggage;

2) who transferred (are being transferred) the goods for personal use to a carrier, including vehicles for personal use transported across the border of the Republic of Armenia in unaccompanied baggage;

3) who are consignors of the goods for personal use or consignees of goods for personal use sent via international postal items;

4) On behalf or by the address of whom the goods for personal use, including vehicles for personal use, are delivered by a carrier;

5) who have the right of ownership in respect of the vehicle for personal use, the customs declaration of which is carried out for release into free circulation;

6) who travel across the border of the Republic of Armenia in a vehicle for personal use that belongs to them by right of possession, use, and/or disposal unless otherwise provided for by the legislation;

7) who have obtained the right of ownership, use, and/or disposal of a vehicle for personal use in the customs territory of the Union that is under customs control, including on the basis of a court decision or inheritance law;

8) who have obtained the right of ownership, use and/or disposal of a vehicle for personal use in the customs territory of the Union, which is under customs control, placed under “the customs transit” customs procedure;

9) who carry out the exportation of a temporarily admitted (imported) vehicle for personal use from the customs territory of the Union, which was transferred to them in accordance with the cases established by the Code.

10) who accompany individuals under 16 years old (one of the parents, adoptive parents, legal guardians or trustees of such persons, another accompanying person, or a carrier’s representative in the absence of accompanying persons, and in the case of organized entry (departure) of groups of minors unaccompanied by their parents, adoptive parents, legal guardians or trustees, or other persons — a group leader or a carrier’s representative) in respect of goods for personal use of individuals under the age of 16;

11) who carry out the transportation of coffins with bodies (remains) and urns with ashes of deceased persons across the customs border of the Republic of Armenia.



Attention

Information on goods for personal use of individuals under the age of 16 is indicated together with the information on goods for personal use of the person accompanying these persons in one passenger customs declaration.

12. Who has the right to carry out the declaration of goods for personal use?

The customs declaration of goods for personal use is carried out by the declarant or customs representative and by others acting on behalf and by order of the declarant in cases established by legislation.





- ❑ Not declaring goods that are subject to declaration (including monetary instruments, medicines containing narcotic drugs or psychotropic substances) entails administrative or criminal liability in accordance with the procedure defined by the legislation of the Republic of Armenia.
